



## Amendment 1

### 952.000-4467 PROTECTION OF MATERIAL AND WORK

The Contractor shall at all times protect and preserve all materials, supplies and equipment of every description (including property which may be Government-furnished or owned) and all work performed. All reasonable requests of the Contracting Officer to enclose or specially protect such property shall be complied with. If, as determined by the Contracting Officer, material, equipment, supplies, and work performed are not adequately protected by the Contractor such property may be protected by the Government and the cost thereof may be charged to the Contractor or deducted from any payments due him.

### 952.000-4610 ENGLISH-SPEAKING REPRESENTATIVE

At all times when any performance of the work at any site is being conducted by any employee of the Contractor or his subcontractors, the Contractor shall have a representative present at each site who has the capability of receiving instructions in the English language, fluently speaking the English language and explaining the work operations to persons performing the work in the language that those performing the work are capable of understanding. The Contracting Officer shall have the right to determine whether the proposed representative has sufficient technical and bilingual capabilities, and the Contractor shall immediately replace any individual not acceptable to the Contracting Officer.

## Amendment 5

### SECTION 01000

#### 1. GENERAL

- 1.1. The Contractor shall provide all supervision, labor, plant, equipment and materials (as listed in paragraph 4 below) necessary to perform temporary roofing repairs on structures that were damaged by Hurricane as ordered by the Contracting Officer. Work shall commence by 0700 the day following receipt of the Notice to Proceed. The Contractor shall repair 500 roofs ~~each~~ per workday ~~day~~. The following is an expected production schedule:

<u>1<sup>st</sup> day</u>	<u>200 roofs/day</u>
<u>2<sup>nd</sup> day</u>	<u>300 roofs/day</u>
<u>3<sup>rd</sup> day</u>	<u>400 roofs/day</u>
<u>4<sup>th</sup> day</u>	<u>400 roofs/day</u>
<u>5<sup>th</sup> day</u>	<u>500 roofs/day</u>

- 1.4 Documentation of completed work should include pre- and ~~port~~ post-repair digital photos detailing repairs completed.

## Amendment 10

### 7. BEST PRACTICES

Best Practices to repair small areas of damage on roofs that are either asphalt shingle or asphalt rolled roofs. A small roof repair is defined as a cumulative 50 square foot area over the entire roof. For Small Area Repairs, innovative practices shall be implemented that effectively implement alternatives to the use of Government furnished plastic and minimizes the associated installation damage to the roof to both asphalt shingle or asphalt rolled roofs. Reasonableness, affordability, acceptability, realism, and best value to the Government shall be concepts implemented in these practices. The contractor shall also define how proposed practices will be shared with contractor staff and implemented in the field during responses.
